#### 4. 2026 Budget

- Since the previous board meeting, the budget has been reviewed with numerous changes, including a revised forecast Student Service Levy (SSL) for 2026.
- One major change includes proposed movement of Grad Ball from Addington Racecourse to Fat Eddies. Although this venue reduces the number of attendees, it is the most costs effective for LUSA.
- Costs which were set to increase for 2026 have been reduced to the 2025 budgeted amount with assumption that cheaper catering and other services can be found.
- Garden Party will have reduced costs with Maori Wardens no longer needed and also Without Waste (WOW) to no longer be utilised. The Events coordinator and General Manger will work with the Sustainability Reps to look into creating an internal waste management plan.
- Current costs for Garden Party in regards with lighting and stages are being reviewed and actioned where possible. Sensory spaces for Garden Party will also be looked towards for 2026.
- If the internal waste management plan does not seem viable to the Events Coordinator or Sustainability Rep in 2026, this will be revaluated to having WOW onsite will need to occur
